

**TERMS AND CONDITIONS
APPLICABLE TO RIGHT FOR USE
OF COLUMBARIUM NICHE**

The Columbarium of St. Peter's Evangelical Lutheran Church is a collection of Niches designed to house urns containing cremated remains. St. Peter's Columbarium has been established to bring back the churchyard tradition for members of St. Peter's Congregation to permanently house their remains with utmost dignity and respect, on the grounds of St. Peter's Evangelical Lutheran Church Cemetery.

1. St. Peter's Columbarium is available for the cremated human remains from deceased members of St. Peter's Evangelical Lutheran Church in North Wales, PA. and their immediate family. (spouse, children and stepchildren)
2. Each Niche includes a compartment, (11"depth) x (7"width) x (10"height), that will be a permanent receptacle for two urns or boxes containing the cremated remains. The cremated remains of each person must be placed in an appropriate urn or box that fits into the Niche compartment. Each urn or box should not exceed the size (5 ½"depth) x (5 ½"width) x (7" high).
3. The Purchaser, a family member or a relative is responsible for providing an appropriate and proper size urn or box that will hold the cremated remains within the Niche.
4. The cost of the Niche includes a Cast Bronze Companion Plaque. The Bronze Companion Plaque will show the FAMILY SURNAME and will be ordered at the time when the Niche is purchased. The Scroll Plaque, showing the FIRST PERSONS' NAME, the Date of Birth and the Date of Death, whose cremated remains are to reside in the Niche will be ordered after death and affixed after that persons' interment. If required, the Scroll Plaque showing the SECOND PERSONS' NAME, the Date of Birth and the Date of Death, will be ordered after death and affixed after that persons' interment. A death certificate is required for each persons' interment. St. Peter's Evangelical Lutheran Church will be responsible for furnishing and attaching the Cast Bronze Companion Plaque including the scroll plaque(s) on the Niche as needed. Ref: Attachment 1. EXHIBIT (CP), for additional data on the Companion Plaque & Scroll Plaque.
5. No other words or symbols will be permitted on any Niche, except for an emblem to identify Military Veterans. Ref: Attachment 2 for Military Veterans of the United States of America.
6. The assignment or transfer of Niche(s) may only be made by written consent and approval of St. Peter's Evangelical Lutheran Church of North Wales, PA and will be evidenced by a new Columbarium Contract executed in-lieu of and in-place of the existing Columbarium Contract which then will be duly canceled.
7. Alteration, ornamentation and/or embellishments of any kind shall not be made, removed, nor placed on the Columbarium, the Niches or on the Cast Bronze Companion Plaques.
8. St. Peter's Evangelical Lutheran Church will maintain the Columbarium but will assume no liability for the cremated remains other than to afford them same protection it provides its other property.
9. The PURCHASER agrees that he or she has read the CERTIFICATE OF RIGHT FOR USE OF COLUMBARIUM NICHE, COLUMBARIUM CONTRACT and the TERMS AND CONDITIONS. The PURCHASER understands that there are no conditions or representations other than those contained therein.
10. It is intended that the CERTIFICATE OF RIGHT FOR USE OF COLUMBARIUM NICHE - THE COLUMBARIUM CONTRACT and the APPLICABLE TERMS AND CONDITIONS shall be binding upon the successors and assigns of the parties hereto.
